Santa Fe Showdown. Confederate Colonel Trey Marsh gets caught in the middle of a range war between Apaches and paid assassins.

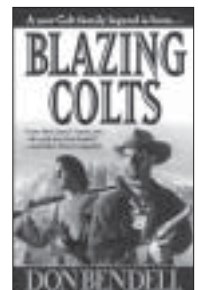
Bean, Frederic and Thompson, J. M.

Gun Gentleman. When Bill finds himself on the wrong side of the law, he vows to clear his name and live as a free man, not to be hunted down and trapped as an animal.

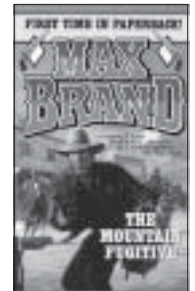
Lost Wolf. Cheyenne raiders attack a wagon train and slaughter all the settlers except the one boy they plan to raise.

Silvertip. Silvertip takes an oath to track down Bandini and put the sidewinder six feet under.

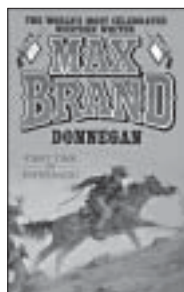
Singing Guns. A sheriff takes a chance that a deadly bad man will go straight.
